III. Criteria for Each Competition

Code 01: Scientific Paper Presentation

Theme: *“Learning Today, Leading Tomorrow: The Journey of a Nursing Student”*

The research article should follow these guidelines:

- Introduction
- Need and Significance in Nursing
- Statement of the Problem
- Methodology
- Interpretation of Findings (presented in one or two tables)
- Discussion (based on previous studies)
- Recommendations
- Conclusion
- Bibliography

Please note the scientific paper shall not exceed 2,000 words.

Selection and Participation Guidelines

i. Unit Level:

The Unit SNAI Advisor may guide students in conducting research on the given theme and select the best study to be forwarded to the State SNAI Advisor for further scrutiny at the state level.

ii. State Level:

The State SNAI Advisor, with the support of the TNAI Branch executives, will select the best scientific paper at the state level and forward it to the TNAI Headquarters by **31st August 2025** for final evaluation at the national level.

If it is a group study (maximum of three students), only **one student nurse** will be permitted to present the study during the conference. However, all three students will be allowed to attend the conference. The details of the other two student researchers must be mentioned in the registration form.

iii. National Level:

The TNAI Headquarters will select the top three scientific papers and notify the **State SNAI Advisor, the respective principal of the SNAI Unit, and the student researcher(s).** For a group study, all three students will be invited to attend the **SNAI Biennial Conference 2025**, but only one student will be permitted to present the paper during the conference. The **TNAI Headquarters** will reimburse the round-trip **three-tier AC rail fare** for student researchers maximum three per study, and additionally, **Rs. 1,000/- per Student for local transportation.**

Code 02: National award for best SNAI Unit in India

Criteria for Evaluating the Best SNAI Unit Report

i. **Establishment Details**

Year of establishment of the Institution and the year of establishment of the SNAI unit.

ii. **Continuous Renewal**

Uninterrupted renewal of the unit over the last three years (2023, 2024, & 2025) by regularly paying SNAI subscriptions to the National level on time.

iii. **Participation in SNAI Conferences (2023)**

Number of SNAI conferences attended by the unit at the State and National levels.

iv. **Awards and Achievements (2023)**

Number of awards received at the National Conference.

v. **Unit Report Submission**

- a. The report must include details of all activities conducted, specifying the date, venue, and photographs as supporting documents.
- b. The report format may be in the SNAI diary or any format adopted by the SNAI unit. Submission of the TNAI Diary is not mandatory.

vi. **SNAI to TNAI Membership Transition**

Number of SNAI members enrolled as TNAI members in 2023, 2024, & 2025.

vii. **Student Participation in the National Conference**

Number of students who participated from the respective SNAI unit (attach supporting documents).

viii. **Special Achievements and Initiatives**

Any extraordinary performance or special programs organized by the SNAI unit (attach supporting documents).

ix. **Prizes Won at SNAI Conferences (2023)**

1st, 2nd, and 3rd prizes won at the State/National level.

The **State Branch** will scrutinize and forward **one best unit report** to TNAI

Headquarters for final evaluation.

Instructions:

- The Poster Competition will now be conducted **on the spot**, with **two participants per team**.
- A maximum of **two participants per section** will be permitted.
- The time limit for the competition has been extended to **two hours**.
- Participants must use **poster paints only**. Use of fabric paint or any other type is not allowed.

Criteria:

- Poster Size:** Standard size (approximately 22"x26").
- Topics:** Ideas depicted in the poster should be relevant to the topics given above.
- Lettering and design** of the poster should be bold and big enough to be visible from a distance.
- Clarity:** To ensure clarity, focus on one idea that is relevant to the topic.
- Layout of pictures** in the poster must be properly balanced to give a correct sense of proportion
- No Extra fixing** of clippings/cuttings or any other form on the poster and it should depict originality with innovative ideas.

The rounds shall be restricted to only 3

A. Round -1 Traditional attire

Criteria for evaluation:

Fifty percent (50%) of the total participants will be selected for the next round

B. Round - 2 Contemporary / Western attire

One question each to all the participant.

Time: 1 minute

Criteria for evaluation:

- i. Outfit Choice & Styling
- ii. Accessories & Detailing
- iii. Confidence
- iv. Stage Presence
- v. Overall Appeal & Impression

Only the top 6 contestants out of the total will be selected for the next round.

C. Round – 3 Question and Answer round

The judges may provide a common question that participants can write down. They will then read their response aloud when it's their turn, and the following will be evaluated:

- i. Befitting answer
- ii. Clarity
- iii. Language
- iv. Spontaneity
- v. Smartness

Out of the total 6 contestants, only 3 will be selected as the final winners

ii. Kindly ensure that all participants selected from the SNAI units have paid the National subscription regularly under the SNAI-TNAI Membership (New) Plan.

IV Awards:

State SNAI Biennial Best Performance Award

The TNAI Hqrs shall evaluate and select the **State SNAI Biennial Best Performance Award** based on the criteria. This award shall be given during the state conference

State/UT SNAI Biennial Report

- i. The State SNAI Advisors should guide the State SNAI Chairperson/ SNAI Secretary to send the State SNAI Biennial Branch Report to the TNAI Hqrs on **September 30th, 2025**
- ii. The Branch report should be presented briefly through power point presentation. The State SNAI Secretary of each state shall be given 5 minutes to present the report
- iii. Soft copy and hard copy of the report (maximum 10 slides only) shall be sent to TNAI Headquarters before **September 30th, 2025**
- iv. Registration form for the competitions and Proforma for sending the report is attached along with this circular for your ready reference and needful action

Note: The branches who has sent the State SNAI Biennial report to the Headquarters **are only allowed to present their State Branch SNAI report during the Conference.**

Rules of Entry for the Competition

- i. Every institution should have SNAI units and paid the subscription fee for the period of **2023-2024 and 2024-2025.**
- ii. All entries must have competed at the State level. Only one entry from each State/UT will be accepted for the National competition.
- iii. All participants must register for the conference and submit the registration form.
- iv. Last date of receiving the duly filled form from the State/UT SNAI Advisor is **September 30, 2025** except scientific paper presentation and National award for best SNAI Unit in India.
- v. A separate form is required for each item.

NOTE:

i Completed form(s) with the signature of the participants and State SNAI Advisor shall be submitted to "The Secretary-General, TNAI, L-17, Florence Nightingale Lane, Green Park, New Delhi – 110016".

ii In any group item, each contestant must provide their name and address on the entry form to receive merit certificates.

Miscellaneous Information

i. Observation visit Charges for Non-SNAI Units

As per the decision of the TNAI EC & Council meeting held during January 2023 at Guwahati, Assam, the observation visit charges has been enhanced to Rs.50/- per student + 18% GST (as applicable) i.e. **Rs.59/- per student, if not having SNAI unit (w.e.f. April 1, 2023)**

ii. The Nursing Journal of India-Subscription:

As per the EC & Council decision (**Minute No. EC & CL-109/28-29 January, 2023/14**) the members have decided to print the NJI in four color (all the pages) and also enhance the NJI Subscription rates with effect from April 1, 2023.

Subscriptions details are as follows:

For Institutions

One year subscription: Rs. 2,000/-

Five years subscription: Rs. 9,000/-

For Individuals

One year subscription: Rs. 1,500/-

Five years subscription for Individuals: Rs. 6,500/-

iii. SNAI Membership Plan

a) SNAI-TNAI Membership Plan (New Plan)

This is a one-time payment plan under which every student is required to pay their SNAI subscription during their 1st year. This fee includes an SNAI Subscription for 4 years, a Scholarship fund, and an **SNAI to TNAI membership** fee.

After the payment, each student will get an individual SNAI - TNAI Membership Card within 15-20 days.

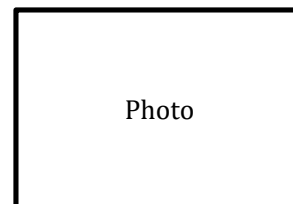
