## Guidelines for DHFC- N Awards 2026

Category	Award	Selection criteria
<b>Top Performing State</b>	Rs. 1,50,000*	The State Branch with the highest number of members who have successfully completed the course and received the certificate will be declared the winner.
<b>Best Performing Institute</b>	Rs. 75,000	The Institute with the highest number of Student Nurses who have successfully completed the course and received the certificate will be declared the winner.
<b>Fast Track Learner Awards:</b>	Rs. 1000* for first 5 SNAI and 5 TNAI members	Winners will be announced every 10 days. TNAI/SNAI members who successfully complete the course in the shortest time and receive their certificates will be declared as winners.
<b>Digital Health Champion Nurse</b>	<b>Rs. 25,000+ Trophy</b> <b>Criteria:</b> <b>Registered nurses who have:</b>  1. Successfully completed DHFC-N and received the certificate 2. Applied digital health tools in real-world practice, such as: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Hospital Management Information System (HMIS)</li><li>• Electronic Medical Record (EMR)</li><li>• Telemedicine/ Telenursing</li><li>• Personal Health Apps and Devices</li><li>• Any ABDM-aligned digital health workflow</li></ul>
