- Coordinate servicing and repairs of simulation equipment as required.

## 4. Quality Assurance and Evaluation

- Assess learner performance, provide constructive feedback, and evaluate learning outcomes.
- Participate in quality improvement initiatives related to simulation activities.

## 5. Training and Support

- Provide orientation and training to faculty, staff, and students on simulation methodologies and equipment.
- Support faculty in designing and implementing simulation-based educational strategies.

## 6. Documentation and Reporting

- Maintain accurate records of simulation sessions, attendance, and assessment outcomes.
- Prepare reports and submit them to the Deputy Secretary General.
