विश्व स्वास्थ्य दिवस

संप्रति खासी तादाद में लोग दुनियाभर में हाइपरटेंशन, डायबिटीज़, टीबी, डिप्रेशन व अनेक मानसिक बीमारियों से जूझ रहे हैं जिसके अनेक कारण हैं। पहला उन्हें मर्ज की उचित जानकारी नहीं होती, दूसरा डाक्टर और स्वास्थ्यकर्मी उनकी पहुंच में नहीं हैं। तीसरा – अस्वस्थ लोगों के पास नैदानिक परीक्षण और इलाज के लिए पैसा नहीं है। इस असंतोषजनक स्थिति के लिए कुछ हद तक शासकीय कोताही भी जिम्मेदार है। खानपान के अप्राकृतिक तौरतरीकों से भी कुछ बीमारियों में इजाफा दर्ज हो रहा है।

इन सबके बावजूद, कुछ बीमारियां ऐसी हैं (इनमें असाध्य मानी जाती बीमारियां भी हैं) जिनसे सामान्य रोकथाम तरीके अपनाते हुए बचा जा सकता है। विश्व स्वास्थ्य संगठन (डब्ल्यूएचओ) वर्ष 1948 से 7 अप्रैल को प्रतिवर्ष विश्व स्वास्थ्य दिवस का आयोजन इस उद्देश्य से करता है कि जन समुदाय को अच्छे स्वास्थ्य के प्रति सजग रखा जाए, विशेषकर गंभीर बीमारियों से बचाव के बारे में सही जानकारी सुलभ कराई जाए। हर वर्ष एक थीम चुना जाता है, इस वर्ष का थीम है, जन-जन तक स्वास्थ्य सुविधाओं की पहुंच।

हालात यों हैं कि विश्व की आधी जनसंख्या को आवश्यक स्वास्थ्य सेवाएं भलीभांति नहीं सुलभ होतीं। दस करोड़ व्यक्ति इसलिए ठीक से गुजर बसर नहीं कर सकते चूंकि उन्हें इलाज आदि पर खासी रकम खर्चनी पड़ती है। विश्व के 12 फीसद (80 करोड़) व्यक्ति घरेलू बजट का दसवां हिस्सा इस निमित्त खर्च करने को विवश होते हैं। नतीजन निर्धनता के कुचक्र से निकलना उनके लिए दुष्कर हो जाता है।

डब्ल्यूएचओ के एसडीजी लक्ष्यों में 2030 तक मंशा है कि सभी को आवश्यक स्वास्थ्य सुविधाएं मिल जानी चाहिए, इनमें उच्चस्तरीय सेवाएं, रोकथाम के साधन, पुनर्वास आदि सम्मिलित हैं।

डब्ल्यूएचओ विश्व समुदाय के लाभार्थ एसडीजी लक्ष्यों की प्राप्ति के अलावा सार्वभौम उपयोगी और व्यवहार्य स्वास्थ्य नीतियां तैयार करता है और इनके क्रियान्वयन और मॉनीटरिंग जैसे कार्य भी करता है।

अंतर्राष्ट्रीय नर्स परिषद् क्या है ?

वर्ष 1899 में स्थापित, समूचे विश्व में दो करोड़ नर्सों की प्रतिनिधि संस्था अंतर्राष्ट्रीय नर्स परिषद् (आईसीएन) स्वायत्तियों का सबसे विशाल संगठन है। इसका संचालन अग्रणी नर्सों द्वारा किया जाता है। आईसीएन के प्रमुख कार्य हैं: सभी के लिए स्तरीय नर्सिंग सेवाएं उपलब्ध कराना; उन्नत स्वास्थ्य नीतियों की अनुपालना सुनिश्चित कराना, नर्सिंग क्षेत्र में जानकारी को समृद्ध और अद्यतन कराना, और सर्वत्र सक्षम व संतुष्ट नर्सकर्मियों की मौजूदगी के लिए प्रयासरत रहना। यह वैश्विक स्तर पर नर्सों व अन्य स्वास्थ्यकर्मियों के हितों के भी प्रयास करता है।

आईसीएन के महत्वपूर्ण कार्यक्रमों में प्रतिवर्ष 12 मई को अंतर्राष्ट्रीय नर्स दिवस (आईएनडी) का आयोजन है। इस दिन विश्वभर के नर्सिंग संस्थान कार्यशालाएं, वार्ताएं और संगोष्ठियां आयोजित करते हैं। इस अवसर पर आईसीएन अन्य गतिविधियों के अतिरिक्त एक आईएनडी किट जारी करता है जिसमें विश्व के विभिन्न अंचलों के लिए स्वास्थ्य संस्तुतियां प्रस्तुत की जाती हैं।

International Nurses Day 2019

International Nurses Day, celebrated on 12 May in over 130 countries by nurses and other health functionaries is the much eagerly event all over. It is the initiative of International Council of Nurses (ICN), the umbrella body of 20 million-plus nurses. The ICN is operated by nurses and leading nursing at world level. It works to ensure quality nursing care for all and sound health policies globally. A theme of particular relevance is chosen every year, the one for the years 2017-2019 campaign, NURSES: A VOICE TO LEAD – Health for All.

The ICN Code of Ethics states that "Inherent in nursing is a respect for human rights, including cultural rights, the right to life and choice, to dignity and to be treated with respect. Nursing care is respectful of and unrestricted by considerations of age, colour, creed, culture, disability or illness, gender, sexual orientation, nationality, politics, race or social status. Nurses render health services to the individual, the family and the community and coordinate their services with those of related groups. The need for nursing is universal."

As the engine room of the health system nurses have a pivotal role in addressing the multiple health challenges being faced all over the world. They respond to the health needs of individuals, communities, wherever required. IND focuses on the need for nurses to become more active and vocal in policy development and implementation so that primary health care is available for everyone, everywhere. The resources and evidence deal with topical critical issues and highlight the many ways through which nurses are making an impact in improving the health of nations.
