Lifestyle Modifications Can Curb Diabetes and Obesity

orldwide, the cases of diabetes, mainly a lifestyle disease, show a continuous rise, with India among top three countries with China and USA. World Diabetes Day, a global observance on 14 November every year is an initiative of the World Health Organisation (WHO), the International Diabetes Foundation (IDF) and JDRF, this year's theme being Women and Diabetes – Our Right to Healthy Future. The objective of the day is, to raise awareness about diabetes around the world. On this day, activities are conducted by 200 IDF member organisations spread in 160+ countries for educating the public on preventing and managing this widespread disease. International conferences and mass education & awareness campaigns are conducted to discuss advances in diabetes treatments and screening of 'at risk' persons. India, dubbed as diabetes capital of world, is home to 69.2 million people living with it.

Closely related with diabetes is Obesity, implicated in many diseases mainly heart problems, diabetes, osteoarthritis besides reduced life expectancy. The sedentary lifestyle of modern living with little scope for physical exercise and outdoor activities are attributed to growing menace of obesity. **Anti-Obesity Day** on **26 November** is conducted by healthcare organisations primarily in India and the Gulf Cooperation countries. The Day seeks to raise awareness of obesity as a public health threat, and treat obesity as a medical condition. The future of a community or nation depends on the upbringing of children and the values they imbibe in formative years. **Children's Day** on **14 November** urges one and all to take appropriate measures for overall growth and development of children; this date was chosen to coincide with birth day of Jawaharlal Nehru, our first Prime Minister, who had great love for children.

Premature deliveries, insufficient oxygen to foetus and new born, complications during delivery and birth defects in India leads to some 39 new born deaths per thousand every year, two-third of these during the first week of life. Despite reduction in infant mortality, it continues to be quite high. It is to create awareness about

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urgency to adopt necessary preventive measures for health of the new born that **New Born Week** is organised during **15-21 November** every year.

I assume, all those interested in participation in the XXVII SNA Biennial Conference on the theme *Empowering Nurses through Advanced Technology* being held from 29 November to 3 December at Guntur have got yourself registered, if not, please do it forthright. What I assure you is, by remaining absent you shall be missing the opportunity of professional interactions and many enriching experiences. - 1. Last date for receiving Nominations is 18th December 2017 (6 weeks from the date of Publication)
- 2. The election of all the office of the Branch shall be held at the annual or biennial meeting of the Branch.
- 3. Returning Officer and Election Committee Members are not eligible to contest for election.
- 4. Both the nominator as well as nominee shall be a life member of TNAI.
- The members holding office positions in TNAI shall not hold office positions in parallel Nursing Organizations and vice versa. For acquiring the new post the members will have to relinquish the former post.
- 6. A member working and residing in a state or Union Territory shall be the member of the branch of TNAI. In case of temporary change of resident e.g. study; deputation etc. for a period of more than a year, the member shall be given an option for changing his/her membership to the temporary place of resident after informing the headquarters and the former and latter state branches.
- 7. The nominator and Nominee should be working and residing in the same state or Union Territory

- shall be eligible for contesting election and casting the vote.
- 8. The members who are residing outside the country and state shall not be eligible for contesting election.
- 9. Members who are or had been involved in litigation with the Association without first representing the grievances to the grievances committee shall not be eligible to contest and shall have no voting rights and same will be applicable to the members who are facing disciplinary proceedings in their work situation/sphere.
- 10. Outgoing office bearers shall be eligible for re-election for one more term.
- 11. Any life member of TNAI may make nominations for all the offices of the TNAI State/UT Branch, but the nomination for the President and Secretary shall be made only from those who have served for one term (four years) as the EC members/office bearers at any time. A break of four years after two consecutive terms (8 years) is necessary for the President/Secretary of the branch.
- 12. For the offices of President and Secretary all valid nominations shall be included in the Provisional Ballot Paper. For other offices the names of three members having highest number of nominations shall be included in the Ballot Paper.
- 13. The nomination Sheet duly filled and completed by the nominator i.e. complete address, TNAI number along with the signature shall be sent to the Returning Officer within six weeks of its publication in the TNAI Bulletin.

यह जानकारी कम ही लोगों को है कि खीर, सेविंया, हलवा जैसे मीठे व्यंजनों में पड़ने वाला या नमकीन में मिलाया जाने वाला मखाना अनेक रोगों से निपटने की अचूक दवा भी है। वैसे अलग से खाने में यह बेस्वाद है किंतु इसके गुणों को देखते हुए इसका सेवन किया जाना चाहिए। जिन बीमारियों में मखाना विशेष लाभ देता है उनका उल्लेख यहां किया जा रहा है।

अपच (बदहजमी) : मखाने में प्रचुर मात्रा में एंटीऑक्सीडेंट होते हैं, इसलिए यह सरलता से पच जाता है और भूख खोलने में सहायक है। फूल मखाने में एस्ट्रीन है जो दस्त रोकने में कारगर होता है।

डायबिटीज़: मखाने में इंसुलिन बनाने की अद्भुद क्षमता है अतः जिन्हें डायबिटीज़ इंसुलिन न बनने के कारण है उनके लिए यह रामबाण है। इसके चार दाने सुबह भूखे पेट नियमित रूप से खाए जाएं तो शूगर की बीमारी जड़ से खत्म हो जाती है।

किडनी के रोग: फूल मखाने में मीठा नाममात्र का होने से यह स्प्लीन के विषों को संशोधित करता है जिससे किडनी सुचारू रूप से कार्य करने लगती है।

हृदय रोग, तनाव : मखाने का नियमित सेवन हार्ट अटैक जैसे बीमारियों को रोकता है। इसका सेवन तनाव दूर करने और अनिद्रा में भी लाभकारी है।

जोड़ों का दर्द : कैल्शियम से भरपूर होने के कारण मखाना हिड्डियों खासकर जोड़ों के दर्द और गठिया में आराम पहुंचाता है।

मखाने के इन गुणों को देखते हुए भोजन में इसका नियमित तौर पर सेवन किया जाना चाहिए।

कार्य स्थल पर तनाव मुक्त कैसे रहा जाए

करीब 39 साल पहले शहरयार द्वारा गमन फिल्म के गाने "इस शहर में हर शख्स परेशान सा क्यों है" में शहरी लोगों की मानसिक बीमारियों से ग्रस्त रहने की दुर्गत को उजागर किया गया है। तब से मानसिक स्वास्थ्य के हालात सुधरे नहीं हैं। विश्व में, डब्लुएचओ और एम्स दिल्ली के अनुसार भारत में भी, हर पांचवा व्यक्ति मानसिक रोगी है। मानसिक तौर पर स्वस्थ रहना आज चुनौती से कम नहीं है और मानसिक बीमारियों में इस कदर इजाफा हो रहा है कि कछ ही वर्षों में दिल की बीमारियों को पछाड़ कर मनोरोग और मानसिक बीमारियों जीवन को बीमार करने वाला सबसे बड़ा कारण बन जाएगा। इस तेजी के लिए अनेक परिस्थितियां जिम्मेदार हैं। पहला – पारिवारिक तानेबाने का टूटना, जिनसे कठिनाई के लमहों में हर सदस्य को खासा संबल मिलता था। दसरा – भौतिक संपन्नता के लिए ऊहापोह और इसी के साथ जीवन को चैन और शांति देने वाले मुल्यों से दुराव। हर कोई रुपया, जमीन, मकान और आरामपरस्ती के साधन जुटाने में उलझा है। तीसरा – बच्चों की पढ़ाई, नौकरी की तलाश आदि में भारी प्रतिस्पर्धा। मानसिक संस्थान निम्हांस बताता है के अनुसार बेंगलुर में 36 प्रतिशत टेक्निकल कार्मिक मानसिक विकारों से पीडित हैं। संप्रति हमारे देश के आधे कामकाजी तनावग्रस्त हैं, इनमें से 30 प्रतिशत नशेडी और गंभीर पारिवारिक कलहों से त्रस्त हैं, तथा 20 प्रतिशत डिप्रेशन से ग्रस्त हैं। वक्त की जरूरतों के अनुसार आज पुरुषों के साथ महिलाएं भी अधिकाधिक संख्या में कामकाजी हो रही हैं। कार्य स्थल के कारण मानसिक तनाव के मामलों में तेजी के मद्देनजर डब्लूएचओ ने 10 अक्टूबर को प्रति वर्ष मनाए जाते वाले विश्व मानसिक स्वास्थ्य दिवस का थीम रखा है, "कार्य स्थल और मानसिक स्वास्थ्य''। कार्य स्थल में तनाव के प्रमुख कारण है उच्च अधिकारियों द्वारा अनुचित दबाव और यौन दूर्व्ववहार हैं। इंडियन बार एसोसिएशन के अनुसार यौन कदाचार के 70 फीसद मामले तो दर्ज ही नहीं किए जाते। कार्य स्थल में तनावरहित करने के लिए पहले एक–दो सप्ताह तक उन स्थितियों, घटनाओं और व्यक्तियों की पहचान करनी चाहिए जिनके चलते नकारात्मक भाव या मानसिक क्लेश उन्पन्न होता है। अप्रिय लगती घटनाओं और संवादों की सूची बनाएं, यह देखें कि प्रतिकूल हालातों में आपकी प्रतिक्रिया का स्वरूप कैसा होता है – आप आग बबूला तो नहीं हो जाते या किसी आपत्तिजनक व्यवहार पर चूपी धारण किए रहते हैं। अनुचित हरकत पर मौन रहने का अर्थ है इस प्रकार की हरकतें आगे भी होती रहेंगी यानी आपको निर्भीक होना पड़ेगा। अपने इरादे स्पष्ट सामने रखते हुए, और संयत आचरण से आप मन से स्वस्थ रख सकते हैं।
